









Surrounded by coral reef, encircled by shallow reef pools along the outer edge bordering the ocean of approximately 40km perimeter you can find a home for diverse corals and the creatures just like a Dragon Palace. Its transparency ranks the best in Japan, which you can appreciate it in many ways. The breeze that come accross the wide ocean to this island is clear and refreshing. After it gets dark, the Milky Way appears, you would be amazed at the sky filled with uncountable stars.





Six mountains, each over 200 meters high, you can see even in such a narrow island of 15 kilometers long and up to 3 kilometers wide at its broadest point. It appears that the pleats of lands emerged out of the ocean. At the skirt of mountains, a vast rice fields can be seen where the water springs and nourishes them —it is rare to find such a place in the whole area of archipelago of Okinawa. In each of five villages people live closely together by supporting each other. Precisely because of the conditions of remote island, an inconvenience for accessibility, it can make it possible that the landscape in the nature which reminds us of that has been lost in other area in Japan remains preserved.



Program for Experience of the nature and culture in Iheya through all five senses

Experience of traditional fishing with instructions by local fishermen Drive fishing tour by a "Sabani"

You can try the traditional fishing method 'Amijike :drive fishing' with instructions by a fisherman acquired the expertise of ocean all around Iheya. By setting nets at the exit of a coral reef trench that is called as 'wari', we can scare and drive the fish in the shallows towards the nets.

A cultural heritage to be shared for the future Workshop of traditional craft of "Kubagasa", authentic tool for farmers and fishermen in Okinawa.

As one of the traditional folk tools in Okinawa, "Kubagasa" has been used all through of Okinawa as a hat for the shade or the cover against the rain during working in both of farm and ocean, though today it becomes to be rare since only few manufacturer remains to produce it. As for its process, though it takes five or six hours including preparation of materials even for the person of good expertise to complete one, its highly valued art and wisdom is worth to be an heritage to be taken over for the future. You can realize its reasonable and elaborated structure in it that makes it light yet stable when you find three leaves combines with the skeleton structure of bamboo with a stripes to weave it together. Every component is handmade.


- Dew to the shallow keel of the Sabani boat, you can watch the coal reefs closer in shallow waters with guidance by instructor.








How to Get to Iheya Island
